
ECTAA regroups the national associations of travel agents and tour operators in 32 European countries, including Romania (ANAT). It represents some 70.000 enterprises in Europe generating approximately 140 billion euro in 2010, according to Eurostat data. Our Members represent an important player in the tourism value chain, both incoming and outgoing.

ECTAA has set up a Destination, Incoming Tourism and Sustainability Committee, the objective of which is to review all issues that travel agents and tour operators may encounter in destinations (inadequate infrastructure, crisis situations, too stringent visa and immigration rules, unsustainable development of tourism, etc.) and issues affecting incoming tourism (Schengen visa, EU tourism policy, etc.). The Committee recommends joint actions to resolve the issues.

Mr. Andrei RAZVAN NACEA is participating to the Destination, Incoming Tourism and Sustainability Committee, providing valuable input as an industry expert. He also has proposed a unique project at ECTAA for medical tourism, a "Code of Best Practices in Medical Tourism".
